Request for Letters of Interest to fill the ASNA Board "At-Large" Seat

The three (3) year term for the "At-Large" seat is up for appointment by the Arctic Slope Native Association, Ltd., Board of Directors.

This seat is currently held by **Bernice Kaigelak of Nuiqsut.**

The "At-Large" Seat represents all Arctic Slope villages and is appointed by the ASNA Board of Directors from a list of tribal members who submit their letters of interest. The letters of interest must be received by Friday, July 8, 2022 at 5pm for consideration and appointment at the next ASNA Board of Directors Meeting on July 23, 2022.

The qualifications for a Board Member of the Arctic Slope Native Association, Ltd as stated in the Board of Director Bylaws; *"The members of the Arctic Slope Native Association, Ltd., are the federally-recognized Tribes of the Arctic Slope Region, including the Alaska Native Villages of Atqasuk, Anaktuvuk Pass, Barrow, Kaktovik, Nuiqsut, Pt. Lay, Pt. Hope, and Wainwright. There are nine Directors of the corporation. The Directors include one Village Director from each of the Arctic Slope Region villages and one Director At-Large. Each Village Director shall be a member of that Village's Tribe and shall reside in that Village."* In addition to this qualification, the individual selected must also pass the Barrier Crimes Law and will be subject to drug testing, as ASNA provides health and social services to its members.
